HISTORY OF NIĞDE

HISTORY AND CULTURAL HERITAGE OF THE CITY

IN THE CITY OF NIĞDE, ITS ANCIENT NAME WAS CALLED "NAHİTA", THE FIRST FINDS WERE FOUND DATE BACK TO 600 THOUSAND YEARS BC.

THE EXCAVATIONS CARRIED OUT SHOW THAT THE SETTLED LIFE IN NIĞDE STARTED 10 THOUSAND YEARS AGO AND THIS LIFE CONTINUES UNINTERRUPTEDLY. ACCORDING TO ASSYRIAN AND HITTITE WRITTEN DOCUMENTS FOUND FROM THE EXCAVATIONS, THE REGION WAS RULED BY THE HITITES FOR 1000 YEARS, STARTING FROM 1800 BC, THEN RULED BY ASSYRIANS IN 710 BC, AND THEN THE REGION WAS CONQUERED BY THE PHRYGIANS. ALSO, MEDES, PERSIANS, HELLENISTIC CAPPADOCIA KINGDOM OF ALEXANDER, AND PERGAMON KINGDOM EXISTED IN THE REGION UNTIL THE ARRIVAL OF THE ROMANS IN 17 BC.

WHEN THE ROMAN EMPIRE WAS DIVIDED INTO TWO IN 395 AD, NIĞDE REMAINED WITHIN THE EASTERN ROMAN (BYZANTINE) LANDS. THE GREAT SELJUK EMPIRE SOVEREIGNTY, WHICH STARTED WITH THE ARRIVAL OF THE TURKS (1071) IN ANATOLIA, CONTINUED UNTIL 1308. THE REGION, WHICH CAME UNDER THE RULE OF THE OTTOMAN EMPIRE SINCE 1470, HAS REACHED THE REPUBLIC PERIOD.


NIĞDE, WHICH HAS WITNESSED THOUSANDS OF YEARS OF HISTORY, IS ONE OF THE IMPORTANT PROVINCES IN TURKEY, WITH ITS ARCHITECTURAL STRUCTURES, HISTORICAL VALUES, NATURAL BEAUTIES, SIGNIFICANT CULTURAL HERITAGES IN THE CAPPADOCIA REGION, AND ITS UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS. THE MAIN CULTURAL HERITAGES ARE PRESENTED BELOW.




TYANA ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE AND AQUEDUCTS

TYANA ANCIENT CITY, LOCATED IN THE KEMERHISAR TOWN OF NIĞDE, WAS FOUNDED IN 1680 BC ACCORDING TO THE SOURCES AND IS A MOUND THAT HAS BEEN INHABITED CONTINUOUSLY UNTIL TODAY. THE ONLY RUINS THAT CAN BE SEEN ABOVE GROUND IN TYANA ARE AQUEDUCTS WHICH GAVE THE CITY ITS CURRENT NAME, AND II-III. CENTURY AD. THE WATER, WHICH IS COLLECTED IN A POOL AT ITS SOURCE ABOUT 3 KILOMETERS EAST OF THE CITY, IS TRANSPORTED TO THE CITY BY CHANNELS ON AQUEDUCTS. TYANA IS PUT UNDER THE PROTECTION AS A SPECIAL ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE. TODAY, THE WORKS UNEARTHED AS A RESULT OF SCIENTIFIC EXCAVATIONS AT THE RUINS ARE EXHIBITED IN THE NIĞDE MUSEUM.






Niiğde Gümüşler Monastery and Underground City







Gümüşler Monastery and Underground City, located in Gümüşler Town, 8 km from Niğde, is one of the most beautiful and preserved works of Byzantine art. The ruins, which were accepted as an archaeological site in 1973; it was engraved in a rather large and wide rock mass. The length of the eastern and south-facing face of the rock mass is about 1.5 km. The front facade, which is completely rock, was used as a settlement center.

The monastery was carved from the main rock between the 8th and 12th centuries. It consists of a middle courtyard and outbuildings such as the church, underground spaces, etc. connected to this courtyard. The height of the steep walls of the courtyard is up to 14 meters. The large room to the north and the base of the central courtyard were used as cemeteries. There is a two-story underground city on the south side of the courtyard and a church on the west. Inside the church with a closed Greek cross plan, four columns formed from the bedrock were plastered and decorated with rosette motifs. It is thought that at least three different masters worked on the wall paintings of the church.

At the top of the three stripes in the main apse, there is the Deesis scene and the symbols of the Bible writers, and on the bottom strip, there are pictures of church fathers such as Basil the Great from Kayseri, Gregorios from Nyssa (Nevşehir), Gregorios from Naziyanz (Bekarlar-Aksaray).

The scenes of the Annunciation to Mary, the birth of Jesus and the Presentation to the Temple, and the figures of John the Baptist and St. Stephanos on the northern arm of the cross must have been created by a second artist. The figures of Mary and child Jesus on the south of the entrance door from the inner narthex to the naos and the archangels Gabriel and Mikael on both sides belong to the third artist. On the walls of a room above the narthex, a composition consisting of hunting scenes and various animals, which cannot be seen in Cappadocia, draws attention. According to the iconographic and stylistic features of the paintings in the church, it is possible to date them to the 11th and 12th centuries.

GETTING A VISA TO LIVE AND VISIT SPAIN

SPAIN REQUIRES A VISA FOR HOLDERS OF A TURKISH PASSPORT APPLICATIONS MUST BE MADE TO OBTAIN A VISA.

EMBASSY IN ANKARA OR TO THE CONSULATE GENERAL IN ISTANBUL.

SPAIN SCHENGEN VISA APPLICATION STEPS RESPECTIVELY:

- COMPLETE AND SIGN THE VISA APPLICATION FORM.
- THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS ARE PREPARED ACCORDING TO THE VISA TYPE.
- THEN GET AN ONLINE APPLICATION FROM SPAIN VISA CENTER.
- GO TO THE VISA CENTER ON THE APPOINTMENT DATE, SUBMIT THE APPLICATION
- DOCUMENTS, SUBMIT A BIOMETRICS RECORD, PAY THE APPLICATION FEE AND COMPLETE THE APPLICATION.
- REMEMBER THAT THE REFERENCE CODE GIVEN TO YOU WILL BE USEFUL.
- ONCE THE APPLICATION IS FINALIZED, YOU WILL NEED TO COLLECT YOUR
 PASSPORT BACK FROM THE VISA CENTER. YOU CAN ONLY FIND OUT THE VISA
 RESULT AFTER YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE PASSPORT.








AGREAT SCIENTIST: AZIZ SANCAR
